### Monday 7th to Friday 11th July- Camp NZ (children)

Children will stay at the camp for the entire week, fully immersed in a variety of exciting outdoor activities. Paired with local New Zealand buddies, they will take part in bushcraft skills, swimming, eeling, archery, target shooting, pest control, nature walks, and engaging night adventures. All meals and camp activities are included, ensuring a memorable and enriching experience for every child.

Adults will stay nearby in a comfortable Airbnb, stocked with Hello Fresh meal kits, groceries, and a selection of breakfast, lunch, and snack items to prepare at their convenience. Some meals out are included, while others will be self-purchased as outlined in the itinerary.
