Sunday 14th July

Arrives at Auckland Airport preferably am, TBC -

Airport pick up, transport to Aongatete, stop at the pancake house to feed the Eels. (Depending on time of day Paeroa for antique shop visits.)

Check into accommodation everyone will stay at Aongatete lodge for the first night. (Sleeping bags provided for adults, children must bring their own)

Monday 15th to Friday 19th - Aongatete Camp (children) + AirBnB (adults)

Children stay At camp for the week and complete the camp activities

Children will be buddied up with New Zealand children and participate in bush craft activities, archery, target shooting, pest control, nature walks and night activities.

Adults stay in a nearby Airbnb, provided with a mixture of Hello Fresh meals to prepare themselves, groceries, food for breakfasts, lunch and snacks, some meals out provided, some meals will be self-purchase(outlined below). Adults will be picked up from accommodation daily for activities listed below.

Adult activities during camp week...

Monday- nature walk at camp looking at some different plant and bird species. Make bush tea from Manuka, Kawakawa, Horopito and Pikopiko.

Lunch at camp.

Visit Katikati village, museum, local shops and supermarket.

Dinner at "The Talisman" provided, taste some different local dishes. Including seafood, salmon and beef steak. With a tasting of local drinks.

Tuesday- Orokawa walkway. Waihi township, wine tasting and opportunity to purchase local wine.

Hello fresh dinner cooking class. Packed lunch and snack pack to take on the walk.

Wednesday- Tauranga/Mt Maunganui day trip, seafood lunch at the wharf, antique shop, jewellery shop, arcade walk, Cider tasting plank at Te Puna, dinner Hello Fresh to be prepared by group. Night activity at camp, glow worms, Burma trail, Candle trail, call in morepork.

Thursday- Archery and target shooting at camp, visit Bethlehem shopping centre, Guests to self purchase their own lunch at the shopping area. Dinner at The Orchard Restaurant Bethlehem, sharing platters and main courses to be shared.



Next accommodation - Opal Hot Springs Friday 19th - Sunday 21st July.

Adults and Children complete the same activities for duration of the stay at Opal Hot Springs.

Friday 19th July

Depart Airbnb and camp and head to Opal Hot Springs, Visit Mt Maunganui beach, Matamata township self purchase Lunch. Swim in hot pools, dinner- roast chicken, garlic bread, seasonal veges etc,

Saturday 20th July

Visit Agrodome am, Geothermal walk, Self purchase lunch at "Rotorua Eat Street."

Hobbiton pm, Swimming at hot pools

Dinner Fish n Chips.

Sunday 21st July

Depart for New Plymouth stopping at Arapuni swing bridge, Waitomo glow worm caves, Mokau Museum, weather depending feed the seagulls at Awakino beach.

Lunch self purchase in Otorohanga.

Arrive at Highlands Intermediate school 6pm to meet homestay families, children go to homestay families and adults go to AirBnB. Adults to go to Sunworld Chinese buffet restaurant for dinner.



Monday 22nd July to Friday 2nd August - Schooling and Homestay (children) + AirBnB

(adults)

Children stay with a homestay family and attend school at Highlands Intermediate for a short term schooling experience. Each child will be buddied with a homestay child that will also be in their classroom for short term schooling, so they will form a great bond with this buddy. The classroom teacher will also assign a different learning support buddy to each international student.



Adults stay in a nearby Airbnb, provided with a mixture of Hello Fresh meals to prepare themselves, groceries, food for breakfasts, lunch and snacks, Adults will be picked up from accommodation for activities listed below.

Adult activities during homestay and schooling week 1....

Monday- Powhiri welcome, a Maori cultural welcome for the students and families starting at the school. This will include Maori traditions such as Karanga- a cry or calling, waiata-songs, and Haka preformed by the boys of the school. A visit to the local supermarket and also a nearby chinese supermarket.

Lunch - Home made lunch at Kath's house.

Dinner - Meal a Hello Fresh meal to be prepared by guests staying at the AirBnB,



Tuesday- New Plymouth city walking tour, St Mary's church and info centre, discuss Parihaka, walk to Len Lye Art Gallery, Egmont Honey, local shops and visit Puke Ariki Museum.

Night Activity - Pukekura park night walk - Glow worms.

Lunch - Self purchase lunch at Centre City,

Dinner - Meal a Hello Fresh meal to be prepared by guests staying at the AirBnB,

Wednesday- We will take a short drive to visit the North Egmont Visitor Centre on Mt Taranaki. Here we will take a few short walks to some scenic views and iconic photo opportunities. Lake Mangamahoe photo stop, Stratford King Edward park, art galleries and antique shops.

Lunch- A packed lunch and snacks will be provided.

Dinner - Family BBQ with Mark and Lucy.

Thursday- Visit the three sisters geographical landmark, Te Rewarewa Bridge and the spectacular gardens at Tupari and Te Henui.

Lunch- A packed lunch and snacks will be provided.

Dinner - Meal a Hello Fresh meal to be prepared by guests staying at the AirBnB,

Thursday- Pukekura park, Brooklands zoo,

Lunch - Picnic lunch at Pukekura Park provided.

Dinner - Meal a Hello Fresh meal to be prepared by guests staying at the AirBnB,
